- **Retest/rescheduling**

The fee for retesting or rescheduling is \$45.00. Fees are not refundable under any circumstances. If you fail to appear for testing or you are turned away from testing because of unacceptable identification, you must pay the scheduling fee and wait approximately two months for another test date. To reschedule or request a retest, return the retest application below or your admission slip with the \$45.00 fee to the GED Office. If your request and fee are received in the GED Office by 1:00 p.m. on the 15th of the month, you are eligible-as space permits-for the following month's test.

- **Scores**

To qualify for the Maryland High School Diploma, a candidate shall earn:

- a. A standard score of 410 or above on each of the five tests; and
- b. An average standard score of 450 on all five tests.

Note: If you take both parts of the Language Arts Writing test (multiple-choice and essay) and you do not receive a test score for writing, your essay was either inadequate or off topic.

- **Testing Schedule**

Tests are administered over two days. Many test centers administer the Mathematics test and the Language Arts Writing test on the first day of testing, and then administer the Science, Social Studies and Language Arts Reading tests on the second day of testing. Please review your admissions slip or call the GED Office regarding a particular test center.

- **Proper Identification**

You must present one of the following current identifications at the test center to be admitted to test.

- **Current official Maryland driver's license**
- **Current official Maryland learner's permit**
- **Current official Maryland motor vehicle identification card**
- **Active duty military identification card**
