Description: This course examines Korea's history through North Korean and South Korean films, as well as via western academic literature primarily in the fields of History and Political Science. Students will view the films not so much for their artistic content, but for the information they impart regarding Korean thinking on various events in Korean history. For example, both North Korean revolutionary dramas and modern South Korean dramas will be used to assess Korean perceptions of the Japanese colonial era. Other topics to be examined include North Korean society, South Korea's democratization and economic modernization, and Seoul's relations with Pyongyang, the US, and Japan. All of the dramas and documentaries contain subtitles in English.
