Right now I am studying abroad in Nanjing, China for one year. I've been here about two months now, and I have already had an experience of a lifetime. First, my classes are Monday through Thursday, 8:00AM to 12:00PM, all of which are intensive Chinese language classes. I also have a Chinese roommate, a Chinese tutor, and a tutor specifically for Chinese pronunciation practice. I also have climbed Huangshan (黄山), an extremely famous mountain known throughout China. In fact, next week I am spending a week traveling throughout Sichuan with my entire study abroad program.
