Directions for Application

- Only one (1) application form is necessary to be considered for the Education Department Scholarships.
- All scholarship applicants must be admitted to one of the UMBC Teacher Education Programs (undergraduate or graduate) in order to be eligible for consideration.
- Transfer students intending to enroll in a teacher certification program at the beginning of Fall 2009 are eligible to apply.
- Complete and sign the *UMBC Teacher Education Scholarship Application* form, available on the UMBC Department of Education website (umbc.edu/education).
- Submit at least two letters of recommendation. A recommendation form is available on the Department of Education website.
- Submit a personal statement which reflects your commitment to teaching and addresses your record of contributions and accomplishments, particularly as they relate to the Department of Education's Mission Statement (below).
- Submit a copy of your unofficial transcript with your application.
- Have a current FAFSA form on file with the UMBC Office of Financial Aid. If you do not have a current FAFSA form on file, you may not be eligible for some scholarships.
