UMBC in Mexico Application Procedures

Congratulations on your decision to study in Mexico City! You are about to undertake a life-changing experience in Mexico, and the UMBC Study Abroad Office (UMBC SAO, for short) wants to do all that it can to help you prepare for your time in Mexico. Your first step in participating in the UMBC in Mexico City program is submitting an application. Please read the application instructions carefully. As part of the application procedure, we require you to submit the following pieces of information:

- ❑ The attached completed study abroad application
- ❑ A 150-300 word statement that explains your reasons for wanting to study in Mexico City and how participating in this program will relate to your academic and personal goals.
- ❑ One letter of recommendation from a recent Spanish language instructor (or other appropriate person who is familiar with your knowledge of Spanish). The letter should (a) specify how long this person has known you and in what capacity; (b) comment on your academic and personal preparedness for a period of study abroad; and (c) comment on your Spanish language skills.
- ❑ An official copy of your transcript for each college or university you have attended.
- ❑ Non-refundable application fee of \$50.00 payable to UMBC
