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UMBC Affiliate Application Procedures

Congratulations on your decision to study abroad! You are about to undertake a life-changing experience, and the UMBC Study Abroad Office (UMBC SAO, for short) wants to do all that it can to help you prepare for your time overseas.

Students participating on a UMBC Affiliate program should keep the following issues in mind when making this choice. Your affiliate program provides you with a list of services for your time overseas. These services vary from program to program. Please make certain you understand what is included in the cost of the program when you apply. The UMBC Study Abroad Office is happy to answer any questions you may have, but we may direct you to contact your program provider with any program-specific questions. UMBC SAO cannot do so on your behalf.

Your first step in participating in the UMBC Affiliate Program is submitting an application. Please read the application instructions carefully. As part of the application procedure, we require you to submit the following pieces of information:

- The attached completed UMBC Affiliate Application Form.
- Your completed affiliate study abroad application.
- All supplementary application materials that the affiliate applications requires, such as official transcripts, letters of recommendation, application fee, and so on.
- ALL STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT THEIR COMPLETED APPLICATIONS TO THE UMBC STUDY ABROAD OFFICE. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUIREMENT MAY JEOPARDIZE THE TRANSFER OF YOUR CREDITS, FINANCIAL AID AND SCHOLARSHIPS.**
- Non-refundable application fee of \$50.00 payable to UMBC, plus any applicable late charges.**

Application Deadlines:

Fall semester and Academic Year programs: March 10
Spring semester and Calendar Year programs: October 10

** Students whose applications come to the Study Abroad Office after the deadline will pay a \$50 late charge (for applications submitted up to three weeks after the application deadline). Students who submit applications after April 1 and November 1 face a \$100 late fee.
