## UMBC Direct Application Procedures

**Congratulations on your decision to study abroad!** You are about to undertake a life-changing experience, and the UMBC Study Abroad Office (UMBC SAO, for short) wants to do all that it can to help you prepare for your time overseas.

Students participating on a UMBC Direct program should keep the following issues in mind when making this choice. While you do save yourself the costs of having someone do the administrative leg work for you, you alone will be responsible for arranging accommodation, arrival and class registration with the international office of your host university. The UMBC Study Abroad Office works with you as an intermediary, but it can not act as your third-party provider on your behalf.

Your first step in participating in the UMBC Direct Program is submitting an application. Please read the application instructions carefully. As part of the application procedure, we require you to submit the following pieces of information:

- ❑ The attached completed UMBC Direct Application Form.
- ❑ Your complete host university's application, available either on-line from your host university's web site or from the UMBC Study Abroad Office.
- ❑ Non-refundable application fee of \$50.00 payable to UMBC, plus any applicable late charges.\*\*

**Application Deadlines:**

**Fall semester and Academic Year programs: March 10**  
**Spring semester and Calendar Year programs: October 10**

\*\* Students whose applications come to the Study Abroad Office after the deadline will pay a \$50 late charge (for applications submitted up to three weeks after the application deadline). Students who submit applications after April 1 and November 1 face a \$100 late charge.
