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UMBC Exchange Application Procedures

Congratulations on your decision to become a UMBC exchange student! You are about to undertake a life-changing experience overseas, and the UMBC Study Abroad Office (UMBC SAO, for short) wants to do all that it can to help you prepare for your time overseas. Your first step in participating in the UMBC Exchange Program is submitting an application. Please read the application instructions carefully. As part of the application procedure, we require you to submit the following pieces of information:

- ❑ The attached completed Exchange Application
- ❑ Your host university's application or ISEP application
- ❑ Two letters of academic recommendation from professors, teaching assistants or academic advisors familiar with you and your academic work.
- ❑ All supplementary application materials required by your host university's application.
- ❑ Non-refundable application fee of \$50.00 payable to UMBC, plus any applicable late charges.**

Application Deadlines:

Fall semester and Academic Year programs: February 1 (ISEP)/March 10
Spring semester and Calendar Year programs: September 1 (ISEP)/October 10

** Students whose applications come to the Study Abroad Office after the deadline will pay a \$50 late charge (for applications submitted up to three weeks after the application deadline). Students who submit applications after April 1 and November 1 face a \$100 late charge.
