The Maryland Institute of Emergency Medical Services (MIEMSS) is looking for energetic and self-motivated interns in the Instructional Design field to assist with the development of instructional systems and courses that will reach out to the nearly 25,000 emergency medical providers across the state

Who is MIEMSS? MIEMSS is the state agency that oversees a statewide network of EMS providers, medical and nursing personnel, hospital emergency departments, trauma and specialty care centers, transportation systems, and communications. Further, MIEMSS provides leadership and medical direction to this network. MIEMSS also conducts and supports EMS and public education programs.

What type of work is needed from MIEMSS' interns? As a MIEMSS intern, you will work on projects that involve curriculum development, distance learning and content development, or the development of new educational technologies. The agency currently uses rapid eLearning tools to post educational content to a Moodle based LMS, but we are interested in finding new and exciting ways to improve our educational "reach."

What resources would be available to an instructional design intern at MIEMSS? An intern at MIEMSS will have access to our educational support department which includes a graphic artist, editorial support, audio development and editing, and video development and editing. Additionally, an instructional design intern will have access to the agency's IT department, public information office, attorney generals office, top subject matter experts in the medical field, and the opportunity to network with government and teaching officials at the local, state, and national levels.

What about after my internship? When you finish your internship, you will have full portfolio rights to the work that you create. You will also receive full public credit for all of your efforts.
