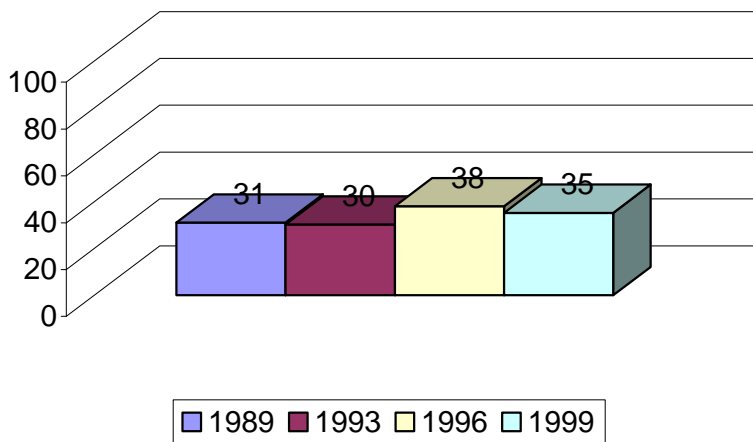

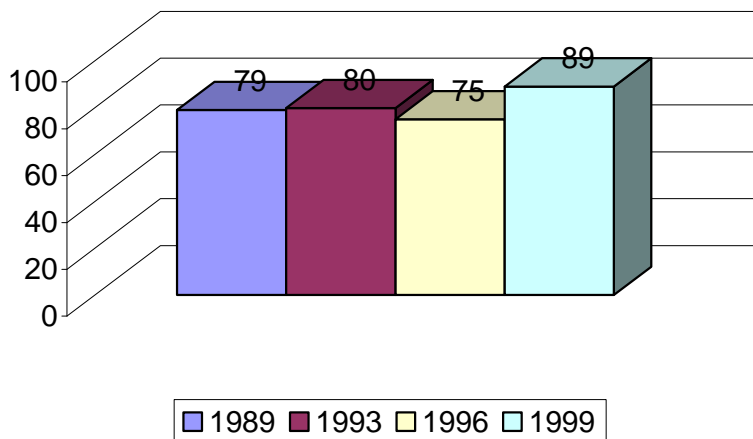




% Seeking Graduate Degree Within One-Year of Graduation

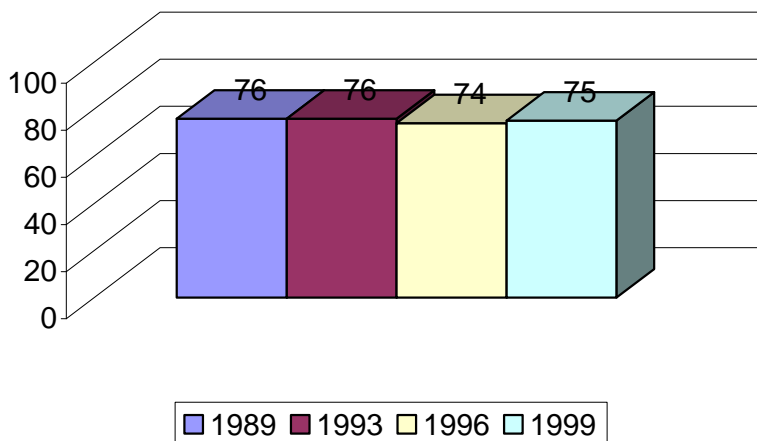


% Rating Graduate School Preparation as Good or Excellent

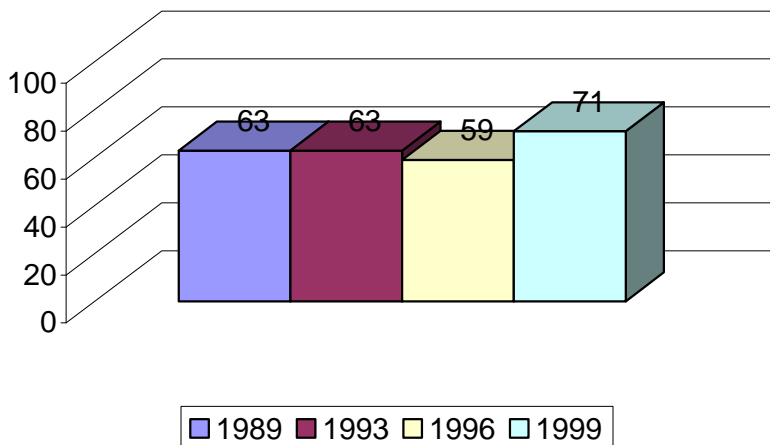


% Employed Full Time Within One

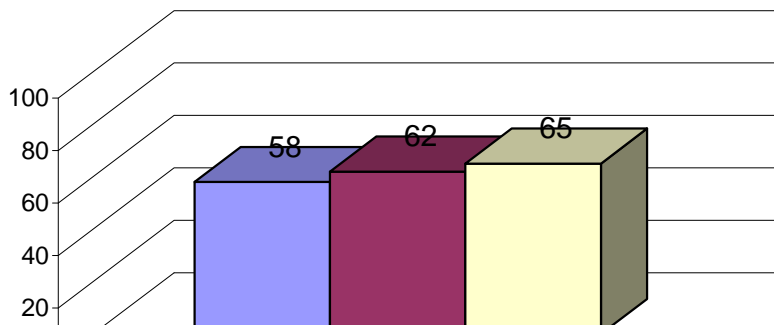
% Employed Full-Time Within One-Year of Graduation

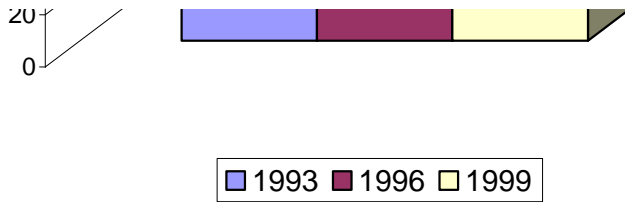


% Employed Full-Time Rating Job Preparation as Good or Excellent

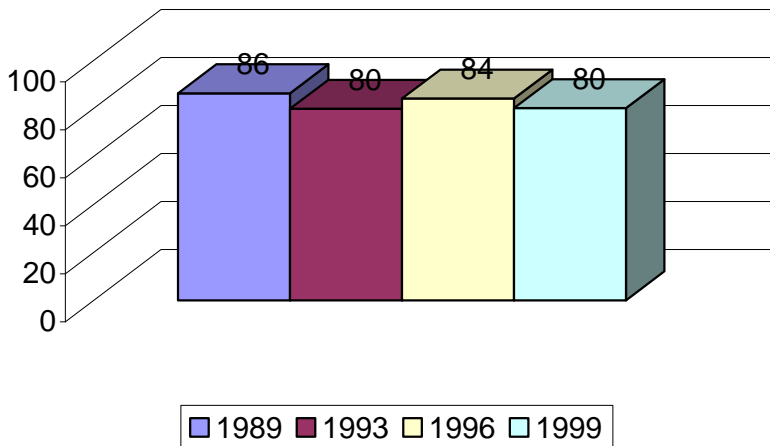


% Employed Full-Time Stating Bachelor's Degree was Needed for Job

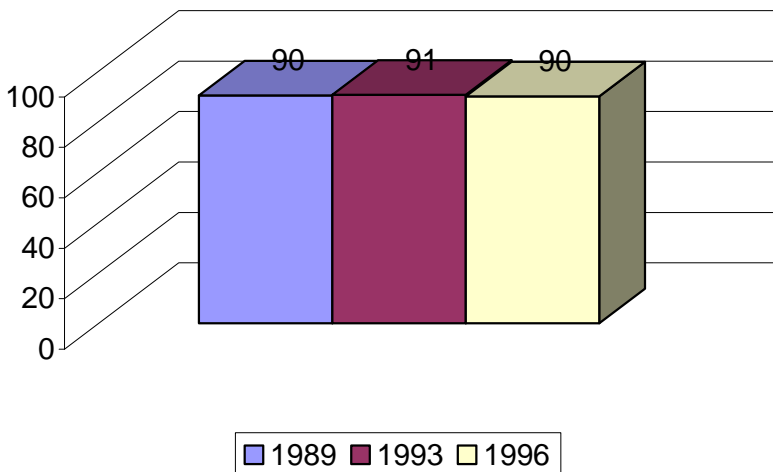




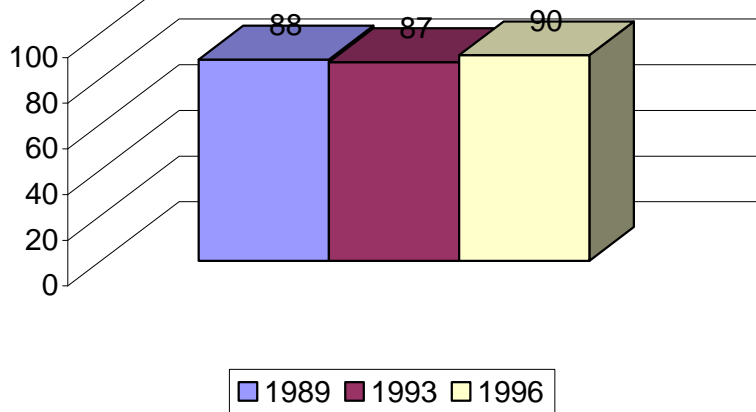
% Rating Current Occupation Either Directly or Somewhat Related to Major



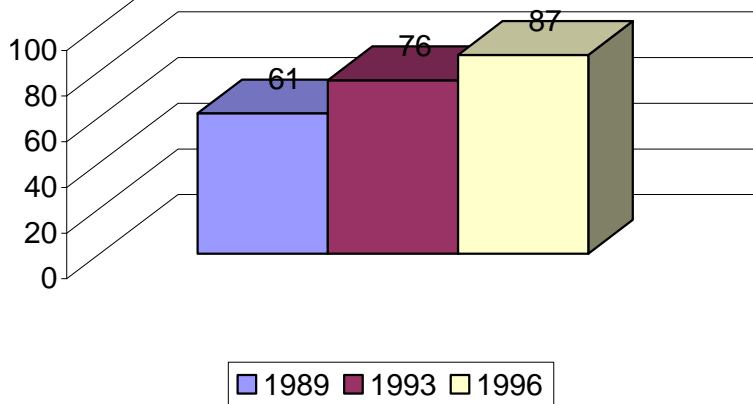
% Who Would Recommend Their Department to a Friend



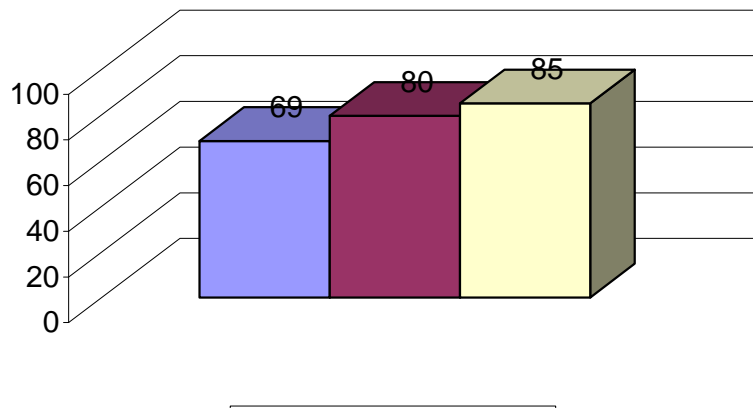
% Rating Teaching Quality as Good or Excellent



% Rating the Library as Good or Excellent

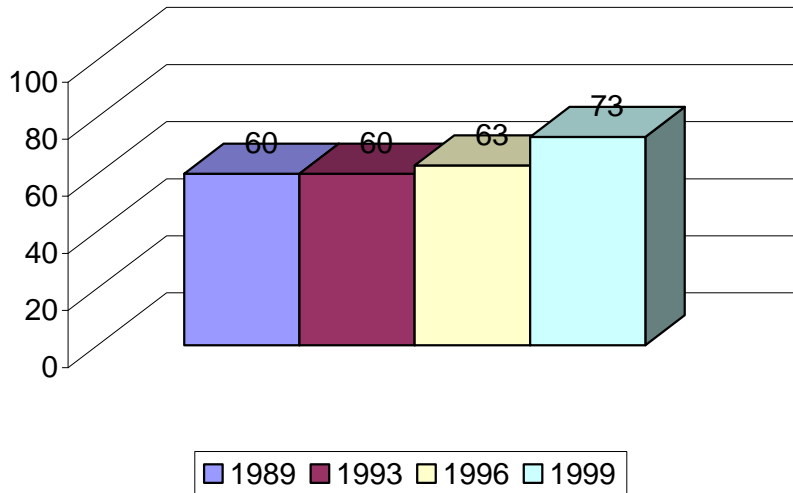


% Rating Computing Facilities as Good or Excellent

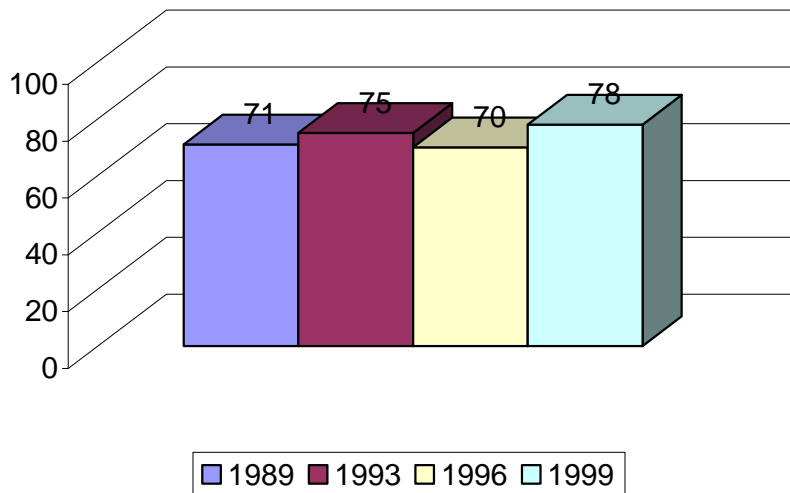
