

VOICE PRESENTATION

An interactive learning tool that blends voice, text and web pages in one location.

Uses

- provides a comment area for student feedback (describe a picture orally/ text also)
- set up web pages for students to interact with; narrate how to use site
- could have students listen to a speech, then analyze it or they could record one similar
- make an activity for library research tools

Entries can be public or private.

Setting Up

- Open Bb class
- Go to tab where you would like to put voice presentation like assignments, then edit view OR make a voice presentation tab – go to control panel- manage course menu, add content area , name it submit, ok then edit view
- Select voice presentation – go
- Give it a title, select amount of time, make it private if grading or testing on an individual basis, submit
- Return to where you placed the voice presentation
- Click on enter voice presentation
- Click on new slide – enter subject, must have url for slide, website, picture, pdf, flashfile, can add description/directions in compose window
- Record narration with red circle
Review with green arrow/triangle,
Pause with 2 bars,
Stop with square
If you do not like your recording, hit red dot to re-do – post
- Can also re-do recording with edit button
- Both students and faculty can comment on slides, click on slide, comment, can write and record, post
- Once comment is posted the name of the postee is in the subject
- To view responses under options - expand all and see where entries made
Can choose continuous play to hear them all – still have to highlight one entry and then green arrow to begin hearing

- Can import audio to Voice Presentation – supported files include mp3, wav, WV (previously exported voice board files)

How to display scanned picture

Every picture must have a web location to be embedded in Voice Presentation

Set up a blog in your Bb class to place the picture and get an address by going to

Course Tools – Blog

On top right, click on new entry

Put title – in the tools bar area click on the **green up arrow to upload a file**

Browse to where picture is (desktop, etc.)

Click on picture, upload, insert, save

Right click on picture file – copy link location

Go to Voice Presentation

New, fill in subject, at URL delete http: then paste your address
