

Oral testing with Wimba Voice Board

Open your Bb course


To make a tab for Oral Test or Voice Board, go to

- control panel
- manage course menu
- +content area
- Name it
- Submit

To add content within that button area


- control panel, click on button in content area
- or click on button, then edit view in upper right
- on far right by +select – down arrow to Voice Board – go
- title it
- describe task, if you want
- click on display messages in chronological order (settings #2)
- under options #3 – make content available, can choose date restrictions
- make discussion threads private so students don't hear others responses
- submit

Please Note- you should run the Wimba Wizard to be sure your machine is configured correctly – must allow pop-ups and trust applet.

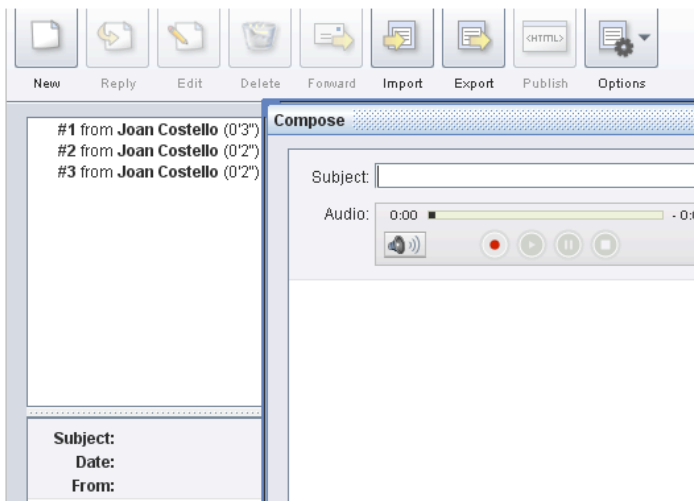

Voice Board added – ok

- enter Voice Board
- Click on New
- By subject – title it
- Click red button to record
- Green arrow to playback
- Square to stop
- Can re-do it until satisfied
- Post to save/submit



To Listen to Answers

- Enter voice board
- Go to options, expand all, then highlight student entry with speaker icon,
- Go to options, choose continuous play to hear responses one right after another
- Or click on individual entries to listen to them – their name will always be listed with their response

- It will play them in numeric, chronological order and all of the responses for that individual question will be listed there
- This will be a good comparison – you will hear all the same responses and you can compare/grade them against one another
- Have a grid sheet/grading table set up ahead of time to assign points as you listen

Click on the green arrow to play the question. Then click on reply on top left, then the red button to record your answer. You can replay your answer with the green arrow and re-do it if you like. When satisfied, hit post to save/submit it. Once it is posted you cannot change it.
