

Wimba Voice Board - General

Can use VB for vocab lists, oral readings, oral response test

Open your Bb course

To make a tab for Oral Test or Voice Board, go to

- control panel
- manage course menu
- +content area
- name it
- submit

To add content within that button area

- control panel, then click on button in content area
- or, click on button , then edit view in right corner
- on far right by +select – down arrow to Voice Board – go
- title it
- describe task, if you want
- can make discussion threads private so students don't hear others' responses
- submit

Please Note- you should run the Wimba Wizard to be sure your machine is configured correctly – must allow pop-ups and trust applet.

Click Chronological order for test – first to last post.

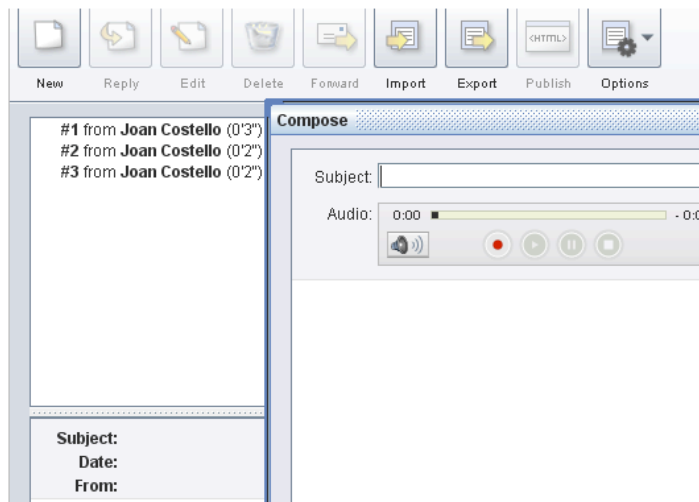
No check chronological order –most recent post at top of list.

Allow students to start new thread –buttons they get will be New, Reply, Forward, Options.

If you make it private students have reply, forward, options buttons. Use for test so they don't hear other replies

Voice Board added – ok

- **Enter Voice Board**
- **Click on New**
- **By subject – title it**
- **Push red button to record**
- **Green arrow to playback**
- **Square to stop**
- **Can re-do it until satisfied**
- **Post to save/submit**



- **if students have new button they can just click on new to record**
- **if it is private they will listen to instructor's recording and then hit reply to record their response**

To Listen to Answers

- **Enter voice board**
- **Go to options, expand all to locate student entry with speaker icon at end, highlight it**
- **Go to options, choose continuous play to hear responses one right after another**
- **Or click on individual entries to listen to them – their name will always be listed with their response**
- **It will play them in most recent entry order**

Click on the green arrow to play the question. Then click on reply on top left, then the red button to record your answer. You can replay your answer with the green arrow and re-do it if you like. When satisfied, hit post to save/submit it. Once it is posted you cannot change it.
