- Undergraduate student staff direct service ratio of 44:1
- Host of CAACURH in 2006, the Regional Entry-level Institute (RELI) in 2006 and 2010, and MACUHO in 2012; we hosted CAACURH No-Frills and other regional conferences in previous years
- Exempt staff have an average of 9.8 years of full-time experience
