Residential Life is pleased to provide Temporary Housing accommodations in the Hillside Apartment Community to UMBC graduate students who will be participating in campus orientation programs. Please be aware that Temporary Housing is available only on a limited basis, and is not guaranteed.

When is Temporary Housing available?

Temporary Housing is available from July 31st to August 14th in the Hillside Apartment Community. Because rooms must be prepared for students who will reside in them during the 2009-2010 academic year, you must move out of Temporary Housing by 4 PM on Friday, August 14th.

How much does it cost?

The rate for Temporary Housing is \$27 per night. Linen service may be requested at the one-time cost of \$40.00 (linens include two sheets, one pillow, one pillowcase, one bath towel, one hand towel, one wash cloth, and a blanket). **Charges for housing and linen service will be billed to your University account.**

How do I apply for Temporary Housing?

For best consideration, to reserve a temporary room, you must complete and return the attached Application for Temporary Housing to Residential Life by **4:30 PM on Friday, July 24th**. It is recommended that you return your Application for Temporary Housing by Air Mail, Express Mail, or fax (410-455-1058) if you live outside of the United States. Don't forget to identify your arrival and departure dates (and times) so that we can prepare for your stay. You will be sent an email confirmation when your Application for Temporary Housing has been received in Residential Life.

Cancellation Fee

You will be assessed a cancellation fee of \$50 if you fail to cancel your request for Temporary Housing **in writing** 24 hours prior to your requested check-in date. Cancellation requests should be sent to reslife@umbc.edu or faxed to 410-455-1058.
