Task: Create a propaganda poster that promotes the image of the United States to the people of Iran in the 1950s.

(Refer to Resource Sheet #4 for the main idea of your propaganda poster) You must use Disney characters from the 1950s in your poster (the main ones are listed in the Resource Sheet #4). Be persuasive and creative. Draw the rough draft of your propaganda poster on a piece of scrap paper. Get approval before you create the final draft of your propaganda poster on the back of this piece white paper.
