<p>CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES</p> <p>Article 1. Section. 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.</p> <p>Article 2. Section 1 The executive Power shall be vested in a president of the United States of America.</p> <p>Article 3.
